

# Red Bull Saloon 25 Glastonbury Festival 21st 24th June 2007



At the 2007 Glastonbury Music Festival, Live LX supplied the lighting for Red Bulls "Saloon 25". This was a Wild West themed area with two bars, a hog roast and a stage that ran from 11am till 3am. During the
